Funding for Affordable Housing Threatened by State-wide Budget Cuts, Focus of 2011 Investor Briefing

State Senate Leader Darrell Steinberg spoke to a sold out crowd of more than 250 business and political leaders at the April 8th Housing Trust's 2011 Investor Briefing. "We are committed to making sure the state plays a leadership role in helping non-profit developers, and for-profit developers building the kind of workforce housing that will allow people to afford to live in our various communities throughout California," noted Senator Steinberg in an interview for KCBS radio prior to the event. Hon. Dave Jones, CA Insurance Commissioner, commented on the California Organized Investment Network (COIN) program which increases insurance industry leadership in the under served and rural communities of California. The Housing Trust awarded three "Housing Champions" for their leadership in the affordable housing arena, Bank of America, City of Santa Clara and Charities Housing, with introductory videos highlighting the very real need for these projects to continue.
